

Logica Verbalis

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Description : Logica Verbalis consists of 50 items, in which one should fill in the given gaps in order to form some well-known phrase/dictum/title etc.

Knowledge required : Although phenomenally advanced, no specific knowledge is required. All items hide well known sets of words, that everyone has heard about at several times in their life, regardless their educational level; something that anyone will understand while solving through this test.

Structure : Items are not set in order according to difficulty. However, categories, as well as some scattered letters in some cases, are presented as a hint to test-takers.

Rules : There is no time restriction. Discussing items with others and/or sharing them in any way (eg. public or private fora) is prohibited. Respect others' work and potential, author's work and, above all, respect yourself and your own, unique, potential.

Statistics : Numerous academic papers have – since many years – proved high positive correlation between general knowledge (GK) and both verbal intelligence and overall crystallized intelligence (CI) (However, correlation with spatial and numerical intelligence alone has proven poorly positive to neutral). Correlation with standard psychometric batteries and various tests/puzzles will be calculated and published (after sufficient data is gathered); an attempt to provide approximate Theoretical IQ per raw score will be made. In addition, separate statistics for native and non-native English speakers will be made.
